Dear Colleague,

I wrote some time ago about the activities of the Iranian regime's Ministry of Intelligence and Security (MOIS) in the United Kingdom, and thought you would like to know of the latest instance of attempts at misinformation against the Resistance.

Recently, the regime sent agents to the UK under the cover of a group called "Habilian". Its members - who pose as disaffected former members of the PMOI now working within a NGO - have sought to contact MPs during the parliamentary recess to tarnish the image of the Resistance.

There are several other groups working as part of the MOIS including the Nejat Society, Peyvand and Aawa Association. The regime also uses numerous websites to spread misinformation against the PMOI, such as

The Dutch and German security services have warned in their annual reports about the activities of the regime's agents in Europe. Our Government should be urged to act upon the resolution passed by the European Union confirming the commitment of all member states to take "unified action to expel and prevent the entry of Iran's intelligence and security personnel to member countries of the European Union".
